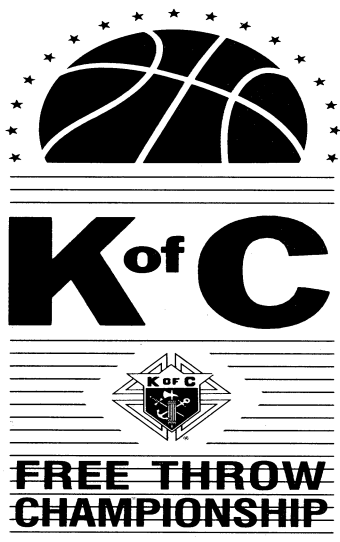

The winners competed at the District level on Sat 2-12-11 at St Vincent church in Osseo. We had four winners from St Al's. They will move up to the region contest.

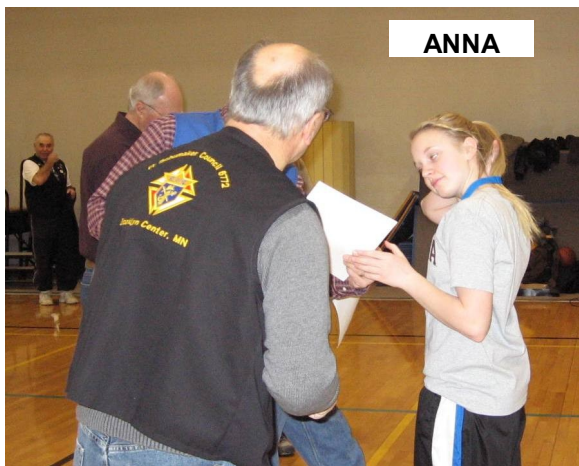
